Silver Anniversary Celebration – Detroit Healthcare for the Homeless

Detroit, Michigan, September 19, 2011 - Detroit Healthcare for the Homeless d/b/a/ Advantage Health Centers (AHC) celebrates 25 years of service to Metro Detroiters.

The October 28, 2011 celebration begins at 1:00pm with refreshments and a brief program, followed by rededication and tours of the new location for the agency's Thea Bowman Community Health Center that opened November 2010.

State representative, Shannelle Jackson will be on hand along with other state and local government leaders. Representatives of managed care organizations and major community health systems will also be in attendance.

Detroit Healthcare for the Homeless was founded by Dr. John Waller in 1982 and incorporated in 1986, to improve the health status of the most vulnerable and underserved population in the area, by providing primary and preventive medical care. It is the second oldest federally qualified, homeless health center in the country, and has grown from a small mobile unit in 1986 to three full service health centers, and a children's dental center. Presently, AHC serves over 20,000 patients throughout the greater Detroit community.
